- **To present information about events and other news, follow these instructions:**
 - 2 days prior to the call, type information on the call agenda (MS Word document) located in the Civic Engagement Dropbox folder. The information should include:
 - Presenter's name, organization, and email address
 - 1-5 short bullet points about the topics to be shared (event updates, status of joint projects, successes, requests for advice working through program challenges or new ideas), with web links as appropriate. The topics to be shared should concern civic engagement of older adults.
 - Post relevant flyers in the DropBox folder.
 - On the morning of the call, participate in a pre-call meeting from 9:00 to 9:15 am to confirm the topics of discussion and the order of remarks.
- All calls will include time for full group discussion.
